



Earth Sciences Internships at Stanford University

Deadline: March 15, 2013

The internship application has five sections that must be submitted online before your application is complete. You are able to save information you have entered, login at a future time and continue where you left off until the deadline.

The five (5) sections are:

1. Contact and Demographic Information
2. Program Interests
3. Educational Information
4. Essays
5. Recommendation

Applications must be completed by March 15, 2013. We do not accept late applications. Give your recommenders sufficient advance notice in order to meet the recommendation deadline of March 23.

To Save: Fill out required areas (*) and press "Save". Save and Submit and Update are the same on this application - they all enter your application into our database. Each time you save your application, you will get an email message. That is just the way this system works. It is your responsibility for completing the application. The system will not tell you what is missing.

4. ESSAYS

Required Essay Write an essay on why you would like to participate in the intern program. Tell us about your interest in science, especially Earth and environmental sciences. How do you think the internship will help you in ways other than getting into college? This is your chance to tell us about your passion for and accomplishments in science and math. Your essay should be about 400-800 words.

Optional Essay - required for Diversity Honorarium Consideration

This essay should address these questions in 200-300 words. How does being from a "diverse" group (underrepresented group in science or low income household) affect your view of yourself working in science? What are the challenges you foresee pursuing a career in science? How do you think your "diversity" affects your interest in or perspective of science?

5. RECOMMENDATION

In this section, you will request a recommendation letter by sending an email message to your teacher. You will identify the recommender by name, email address and phone number. Your recommender will be asked to send the recommendation letter directly to the internship program.

For recommendations, ask a teacher who knows you. It is important to follow up with your recommender to be sure s/he knows with the deadline of March 23, 2013.

This system may seem a bit strange since you will go to another page that seems like you were signed out. That is what is supposed to happen. Please read the numbered instructions. After you save your application, return to the website and click on the designated hyperlink to send out an email message with instructions for the recommender to submit the recommendations online. This will lead you to another page.
